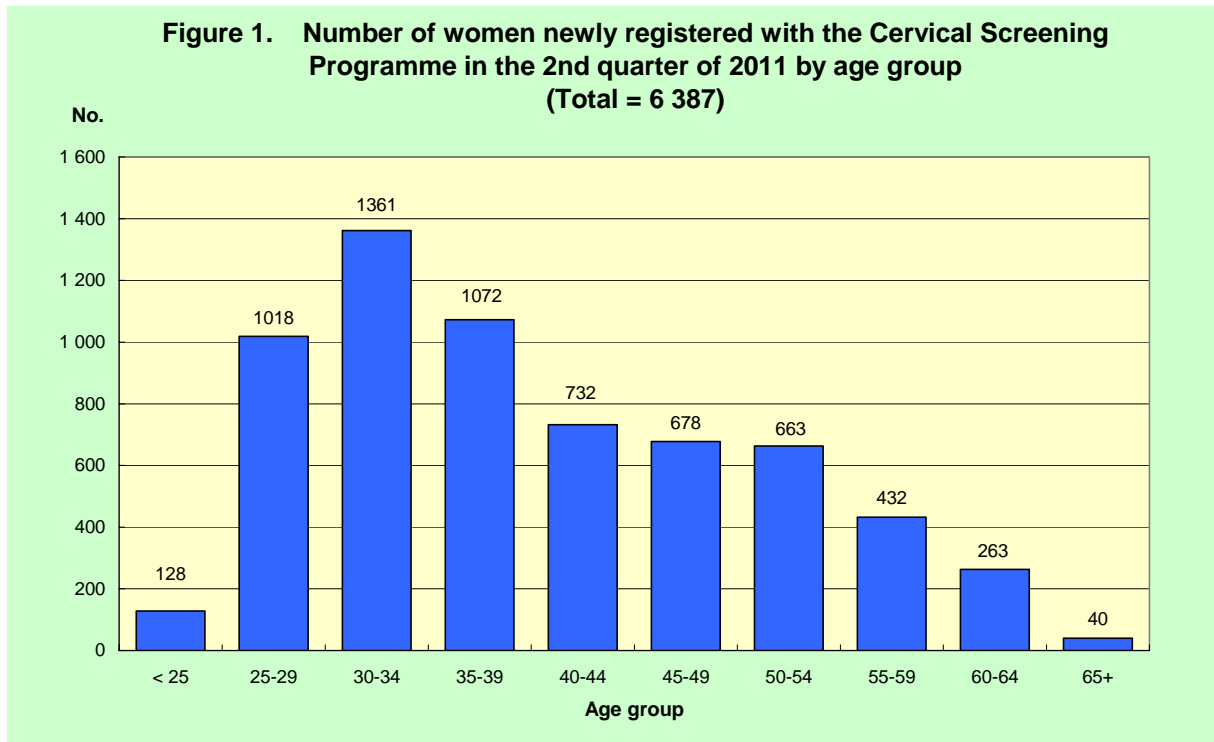


Updated Statistics of the Cervical Screening Programme (CSP) in the 2nd Quarter of 2011

1. Number of women newly registered with CSP by age group

In the 2nd quarter of 2011 (from April to June 2011), a total of 6 387 women have newly registered with the CSP (Figure 1). The top 3 age groups of the new registrants were 30-34 years, 35-39 years and 25-29 years respectively.

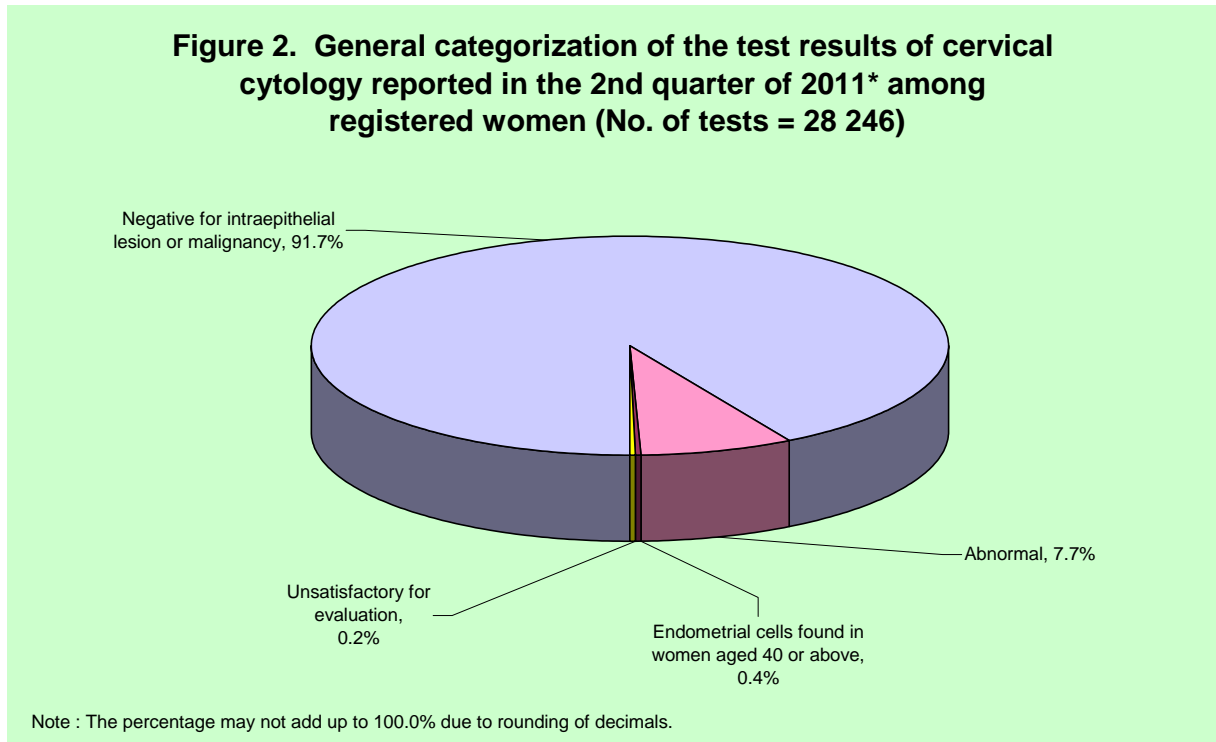


Note: Age of registered woman was calculated as at account creation date in CSIS.

2. Number of cervical cytology tests reported

In the 2nd quarter of 2011 (from April to June 2011), the Cervical Screening Information System has received 28 246 cervical cytology test results for all women registered with the CSP. The proportions of the results as categorized according to the Bethesda System 2001 are shown in Figure 2. Among them, around 92% of smear results were 'Negative for intraepithelial lesion or malignancy', while around 8% were abnormal.
